Rufus P. Yancey, a noted educator, died at his home at Woodlawn, Ala. Sunday evening 3 January 1909.

Mr. Yancey came from Hickman County, Virginia when six years old and located in Giles County, Tenn where resided for [??] years. During the year 1[?]3 he moved to Birmingham, Ala where he lived a quiet life. He was buried from his home at Woodlawn, Ala. On Tuesday 3 January 1909. Services were conducted by his pastor Rev. Mr. Lewis of the C.P. Church, after which the Odd Fellows took charge and laid him to rest in Elmwood Cemetery, he having been a member of that order in good standing for more than 50 years.

He left a wife and three children, Miss Eugenia and John Yancey of Birmingham, Ala. And William J Yancey of Pulaski.
