FAC-SIMILE OF THE GREEK TEXT OF JOHN XIV. 6, FROM THE CODEX COTTONI-ANUS, PRESERVED IN THE COTTONIAN LIBRARY IN THE BRITISH MUSEUM.

This is a most precious fragment of the four Gospels, written in silver letters on a faded purple ground. It is one of the oldest (if not the most ancient) manuscripts of any part of the New Testament that is extant; and contains,
 (1.) Part of Saint Matthew's Gospel, beginning at Chapter XXVII. v. 37, and ending with v. 53 of the same Chapter;
 (2.) Part of the same Gospel, beginning at Chapter XXVIII. v. 26, and ending with v. 34, of the same Chapter;
 (3.) Part of Saint John's Gospel, beginning at Chapter XIV. v. 2. and ending with v. 10. of the same Chapter;
 (4.) Part of the same Gospel, beginning at Chapter XV. v. 15, and ending with v. 22. of the same Chapter.
