I am a first cousin of Eulalia Wellden and we have been friends for most of our lives, she is the reason that I started in this project and I do not know nearly as much about the family as her. I don't have much ducumentation on my family and would have to defer to Eulalia on any question about the family. I have not found any of the names back to my grandfather spelled Y-a-n-c-e-y except for mine and the proof to me is the Tombstones (all spelled

Y-a-n-c-y) and things like a notice of the death of William W. Yancy (my fathers brother) which lists the names of survivors as Y-a-n-c-y. The earliest relative that is burried in the Johnson Chapel Cemetery in Morgan County Alabama is Levi Nathaniel Y-a-n-c-y (my grandfather) (see picture of grave marker L.N. Yancy on my web page). I have a copy of a Marriage Certificate of Levi N Yancey and Mattie Goodwin issued Aug 1974 ,which spells the name Y-a-n-c-e-y, and also have a copy of marriage of my great grandfather Floyd Yancy to Elender Eveline Freeman in which the name is spelled Y-a-n-c-y. I don't understand how it came about but it seems to me that the name has been changed from Y-a-n-c-e-y.

#### Hi Dennis,

My fathers name was Joseph Levi Yancy. I suspect that the spelling of my last name is typical of what has happend to many of our ancestors. When I entered the Army in 1950 I was 17 years old and had a very limited education.

I did not pay attention to some of the papers which I signed and after about a year in the Army someone noticed that when I wrote or signed my name I did not use the "e" and informed me that in all of my military records it was spelled with the "e". After checking with legal advisors aand the state of Alabama I decided that the simplest way was to get a one time change of my birth records.

All of my known relatives spell the name Yancy, also most of the deceased are burried in the same cemetary in Morgan County Alabama (Johnsons Chapel) and all the markers use Yancy. Most of my information in the database came from my cousin Eulalia Wellden and when she gave me the material about 10 years ago some of the names in her documents used the "e" but I found that the grave markers all were spelled Yancy.
