Henry Menefee who married Mary Roberts was the son of John Menefee and Henry Menefee Sr. was the son of Jonas Menefee Sr. Wills on file in Culpeper Court House Virginia, Book A. page 405 and Book B. page 533 show that John and Jonas were brothers and each had a son named Henry.
