

ADAM YANCEY – RESPONSE TO GENEALOGICAL SURVEY



Genealogical Survey – completed by Adam Yancey probably within a year or so of his death in 1920 contains the following response.

"I do not know anything of my ancestors on my Father's side. My Father and Mother separated at the time of the move south – father going to California. I never knew my name was Yancey until I was 14 years old, and have never seen my father. "

"[I] was left an orphan boy at the age of 15 and was a sheep herder for five years [before I was married to Alice Tolman]
