

Waincola Wood for dear

October 9, 1895

Mrs. Miss Nancy Dear Wife
it is with pleasure that I set
down to write to you once more
you are about the only one that
I have wrote to I wrote to Fred
and to Alice and I wrote to add
when I first came here but I havnt
heard from him I am well at
present and hope this will find
you all the same Well Alice I
will try to explain to you
this trouble to you so that you
may understand it when I lay
sick in bed with the chills and
fever there was three of the elders
came to me and they said that
they thought it would be wisdom
for me to write to the president
and ask for a relace or to be
changed to a colder climate

When we was set apart we was
counseled to not stay in a place
that we could not keep our health
and not be so foolish as to stay
in a place where we could not
keep well for this sake of making
it known they said for us to
send for a relace or to be changed
to a heather place I have ben
sick five diferant times it lasted
from 5 to 7 days at a time then
I would feel all right for a few days
at a time so I wrote to Chatanuga
to the president asking him to
be relaced or to be changed to
a heather climate in a weeks
time I got a letter from the president
advising me to go to Long St Louis
he gave me instructions where to go
and what I was to do when I got

there so I wrote and told him
that I would except the offer
for I wanted to do for the best
so it is another week to get an
answer so one of the elders told me
that my address would be bay st. louis
so I wrote to you and fred and neptie
so that it could get a letter that
much quicker feeling certain that I
would be there but when the answer
came back they had changed their
minds and wanted me to stay in
texas for they thought it would be
some booter from this on it dont
make any diferance to me so that
I am able to keep well so it is a
bomence now to be booter now and
I have missed my fever this time
they have been every seven day after
they stop and I think that I will
be all right from this on but if
they should come on me a gain
I shat write for a relace at once

Wells alic I wanted you to under
understand the matter that is the
reason that I have wrote this letter
I dont want you to bring any
trouble for me for I am all right
and intend to be so I want you
to be contented and satisfied for
I am for I know that you
will do what is for the best
while I am gone and if you get
short for any thing you must sell
a bow or more and have what you
need for that is what they are for and
we will find some way to get along when
I come for god has blessed us with
what we have and he will bless us
with what more we need I am
now staying with elder dallas he is
sick now I am going to travel with
an elder by the name of perry from
utah moon and perry is out of
a week now and if elder dallas is
so he can travel next time

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he haint quit his tobacco yet
 but you must not tell that
 I have said any thing about it
 I did not send my suit of blue
 back for I am still a wearing them
 except the coat and I dont think
 that I will hafts buy any more
 but I cant tell yet the wether
 is getting cooler it has ben quite
 windy for two weeks which makes
 its lots better for us we dont
 wear any under clothes as we thought
 we would hafts we pull our shirts
 off every night and ^{hate} don nearly
 all the time Well I dont let the
 things around home bother me any
 for I know that you will do
 as well as I can, I feel as well
 In my labor as anyone can and
 to do what I am

sent here for and I know
 that god will help us to be
 humbell if we try to be alic
 I did not think that we was
 blessed so mutch better than
 the peopel of this place they
 dont know what love is to
 what we do it seems that
 their hull talk is about
 their nabor or how they would
 like to sheet some one out of
 their money it looks like they
 had no love for each other
 they are a filthy lot of
 peopel and they live on filth
 I live on bread and molases and
 some times a verry little of that
 is enough I feel like if I could
 get one meal from home it would
 be a blessing to me well

of course this people
has ben born and raised
this way they dont know
any diferant and I dont condemn
them any for they dont know
any better thoes that we are
with are as good as can be
I feel very sorry for this people
to see the condition that they
are in and how glad I would
be if I could show them
where they are in the dark
but it looks like that they
dont want to know and want
even lissin to what is for their
own good how thankfull I
am that god has ben so
mercifull to us that we
have ben born in the holy
preastood and that we have
ben partakeis of the same
and that he has given us
love to each other to the

extent that he has
for I find that where
there is no love there haim
no hapiness for me will
I write when I can and send
the letter when I can it is
ten mites to the postoffice
is the reason that I dont get
the mail more regular, but how
welcom they are when they come
well I must close for this
time asking god to blebs
you all and hope that you
and the childer will
keep well trusting that
the lord will protect us
all at all times
from your husband and
