

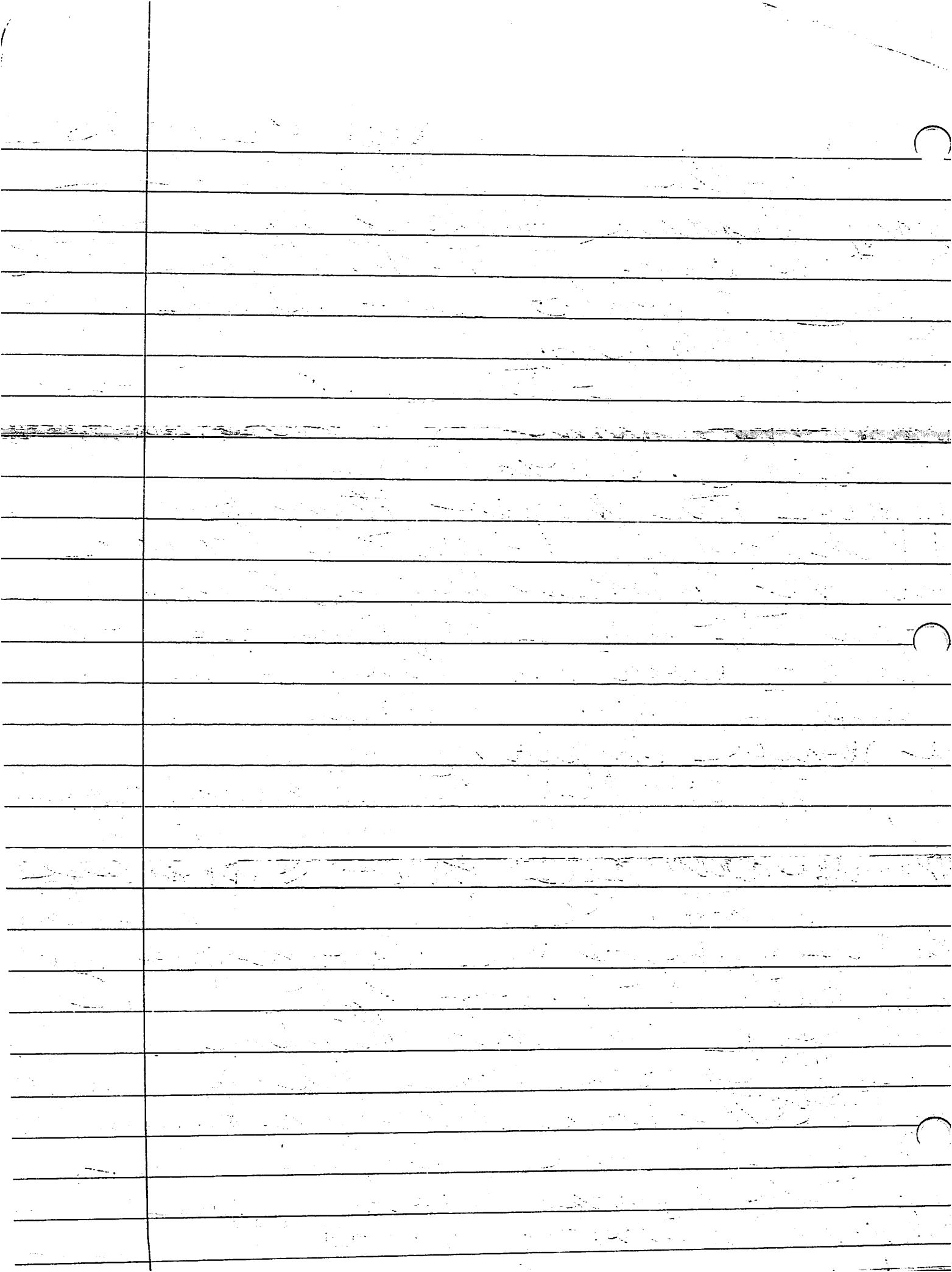
July 9 - 1975 -

Edgar Mother ^{Harold} had them

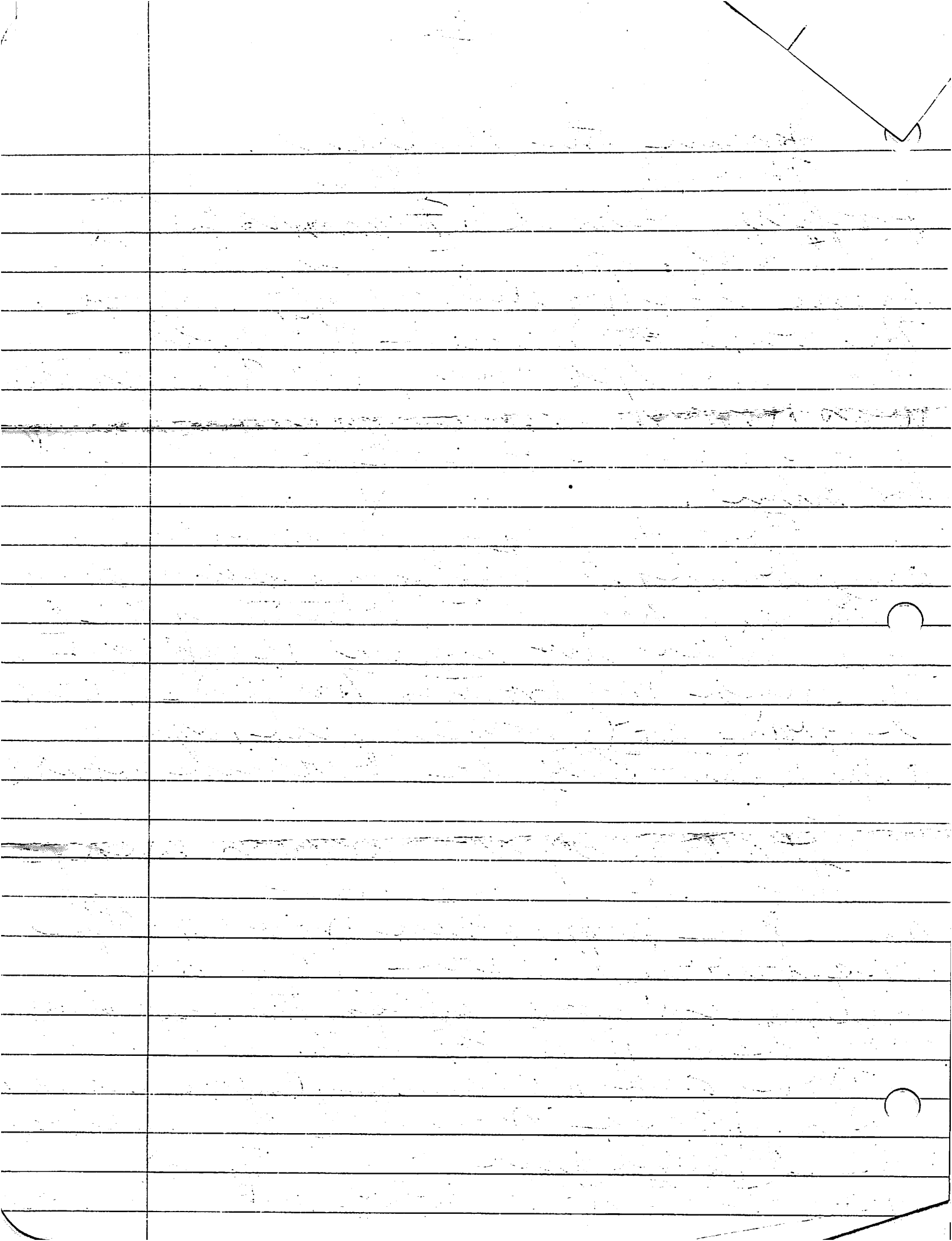


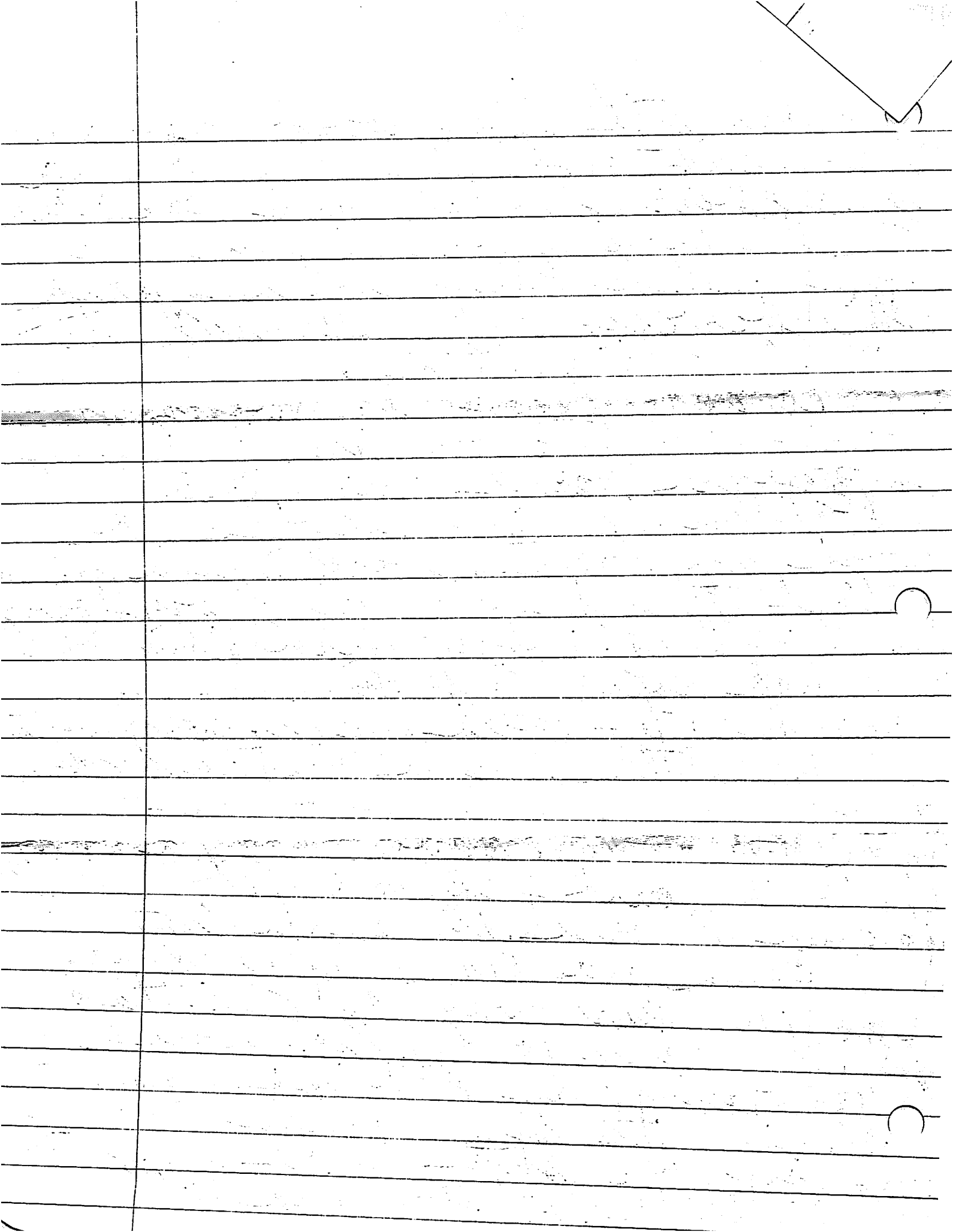
I mean the dimples.
