below zero (average). The last few days
it has been a regular blizzard and

it mild. There has been so many
cars get stuck that people have
abandoned their cars and took to
sleighs. Yesterday (Sunday) everything
in the ward was postponed be-
cause of the blizzard and I am not
sure whether we will even go to
school today or not.

I almost forgot about that closebrack, but I will send it to Hilley's then you can get it before you go.

How do you like your school there? Are you getting thrilled about your trip yet? I sure wish I were going along with you.

We haven't had any dances here since yours but it is advertised that Marie and Joseph will give us one on the sixth of next month. It has been advertised or told also that Hintle and Laval would combine their dance with Marie's and Joseph's. I hope they have them separate so there will be two dances.

Ma's address is: 105 15th Street Idaho Falls Idaho. I was down there the week end before last. Ma seems quite contented there. It sure is good that we moved her because she had quite a little trouble with her ear but it is lots better now. Well I guess this will be my last letter to you until you arrive in England. Be sure and send me letters and cards on your trip to let me know where you are at. I guess I will have to close for this time.
