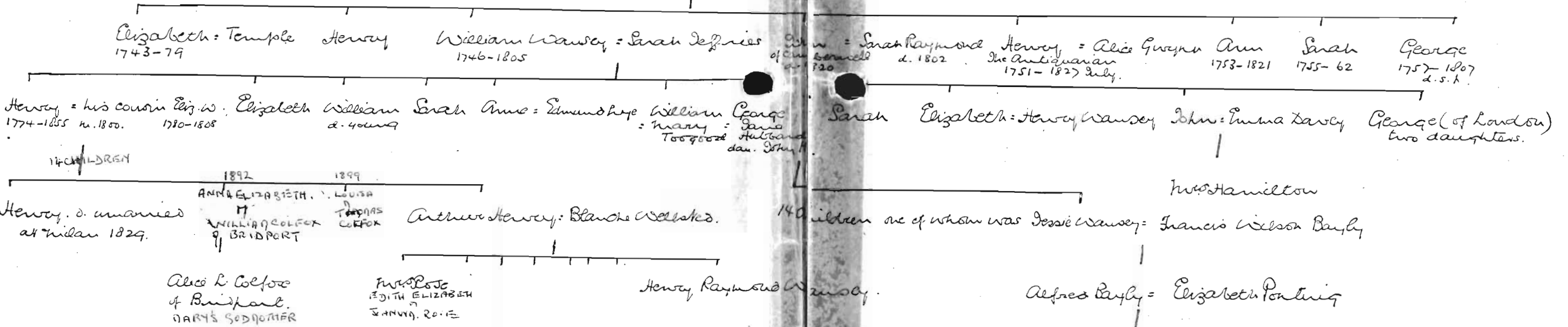


1592. Henry Wansey of Warminster living 1592 = Catherine Stills.

The Hubbards were Russia merchants and one was made Lord Addington.
