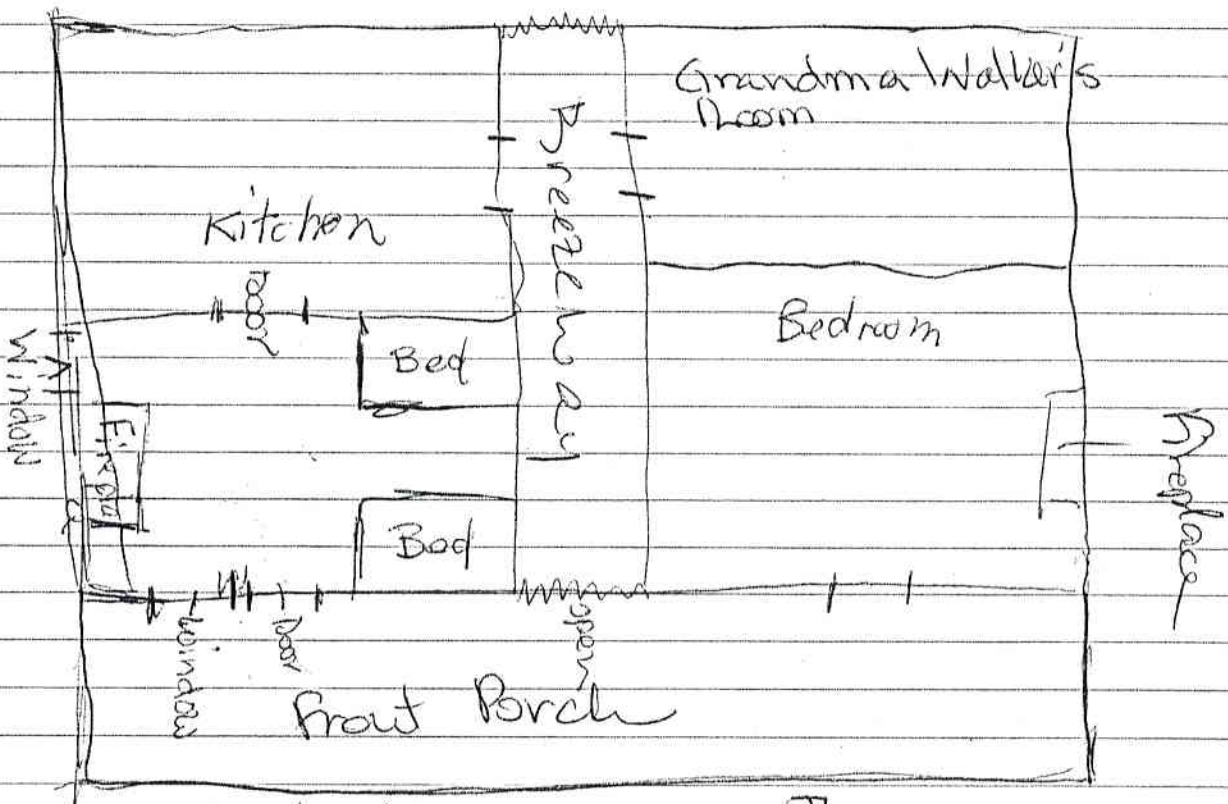
→ Grandma Pancey married a man named Sheets. They had a son - Uncle Tom Sheets. He was Walter Pancey's half brother.

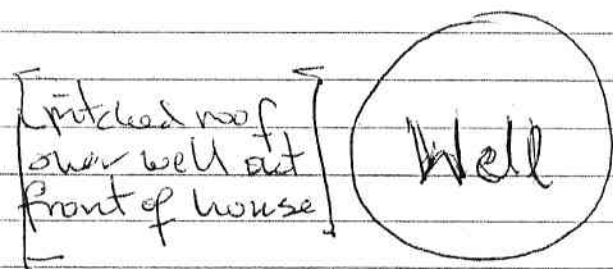
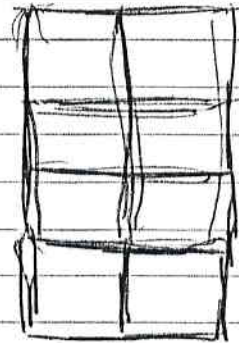
Gancey Family House - Clarke County in the
